

Did you know that 1 in 3 families in the U.S. cannot afford diapers? Low-income families with young children often struggle to purchase diapers and need to make tough choices between diapers and other necessities. In addition, diapers are not covered by most federally funded public assistance programs such as SNAP (formerly food stamps) or WIC because they are not food items.
