STUDENTS CHANGE HUNGER

ALL GRADE LEVELS

Students turn passion into action through this state-wide food drive and fundraiser competition. Schools who donate the most food and funds may qualify to win an award.

TEEN HUNGER SUMMIT

GRADES 9-12

An interactive day of learning, including breakout workshops, student presentations, and service project discussions. This event gives students a look into work being done in their communities to fight hunger and poverty.

GLOBAL YOUTH SERVICE DAY

GRADES 7-12

Students participate in a youth service event, through volunteer activities and community service planning at the CFBNJ facility. Planned and hosted by the Teen Leadership Council, this event gives students the opportunity to learn more about food insecurity and the work of CFBNJ through outreach discussions, volunteer activities, and interactive workshops.

TEEN LEADERSHIP INSTITUTE

GRADES 7-12

This two-day program consists of leadership training, volunteering, and presentations from community leaders to learn about food insecurity and empowering their communities.

GRADES 9-12

Students meet monthly to refine leadership skills and plan youth service events. Students learn how to manage fundraising and social media campaigns.
