Together, we can spread the cheer and hope to our neighbors in need. Every cookie shared and every dollar raised helps provide meals to our neighbors who need them most.

## EVENT SETUP INSTRUCTIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS



GOAL: EACH PARTICIPANT BRINGS 3 DOZEN COOKIES TO SHARE + MONETARY DONATION

### PRE-EVENT PREPARATION

- Ask each participant to bake and bring 3 dozen cookies of one variety (homemade or store-bought
  if needed).
- Encourage participants to also bring monetary donations of a suggested amount to support CFBNJ.
- Provide containers or boxes for participants to pack and take home an assortment of cookies.
- Prepare tables with enough space for cookie display and swap.
- Print recipe cards or labels for each cookie type (participants can fill these out at the event).
- Have a clearly marked jar or box for monetary gifts.


### **EVENT HELPER ASSIGNMENTS**

- Identify three individuals as event helpers per table to:
  - Assist with event setup and labeling cookie stations.
  - Replenish serving trays as needed.
  - o Oversee the packing of mixed cookie boxes at the end of the swap.
- Divide the rest of the helpers equally among the tables for cookie exchange and packing.

### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR SETUP**

- If you have multiple tables, divide participants evenly among them.
- Each table should display cookies in the suggested order below (arranged by type for variety):
  - Drop Cookies (chocolate chip, oatmeal, etc.)
  - o Bar Cookies (brownies, blondies, etc.)
  - Cut-Out or Shaped Cookies (sugar cookies, gingerbread, etc.)
  - Specialty Cookies (macaroons, biscotti, etc.)
  - Holiday/Seasonal Cookies (peppermint, pumpkin spice, etc.)
- Create one or two sample "Take-Home Cookie Boxes" for display at the beginning of the event next to the "CREATE YOUR COOKIE BOX HERE" signage.
- Place the donation box or jar near the entrance/exit so guests can easily drop off their contributions.
