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## SCHOOL AND COLLEGE FOOD PANTRY MODELS

### 1 Client Choice Model

- Students **pick their own food** like a grocery store.
- Focuses on **dignity, personal choice, and reducing food waste.**



### 4 Mobile Pantry

- A **truck or van** stocked with food that **travels to different campus areas** on a set schedule.
- Great for reaching students who **can't get to the main pantry.**



### 2 Miniature Pantry Model

- **Small food stations** (mini-fridges, shelves, or cabinets) placed **around campus.**
- Often **self-serve** and **open longer hours**, located near where students are (dorms, libraries, student centers).

### 5 Pop-Up Pantry

- **Temporary food giveaways** set up during **special events** (like finals, orientations).
- **Short-term setups** to meet immediate student needs or raise awareness.

### 3 On-Campus Pantry

- A **main, staffed pantry** in one location on campus.
- Students **visit during open hours** and may check in with student ID or intake forms.



### 6 Community-Based

- **Off-campus food pantries** (like local food banks) that also **serve students.**
- Some campuses **partner** with these pantries instead of operating their own.
