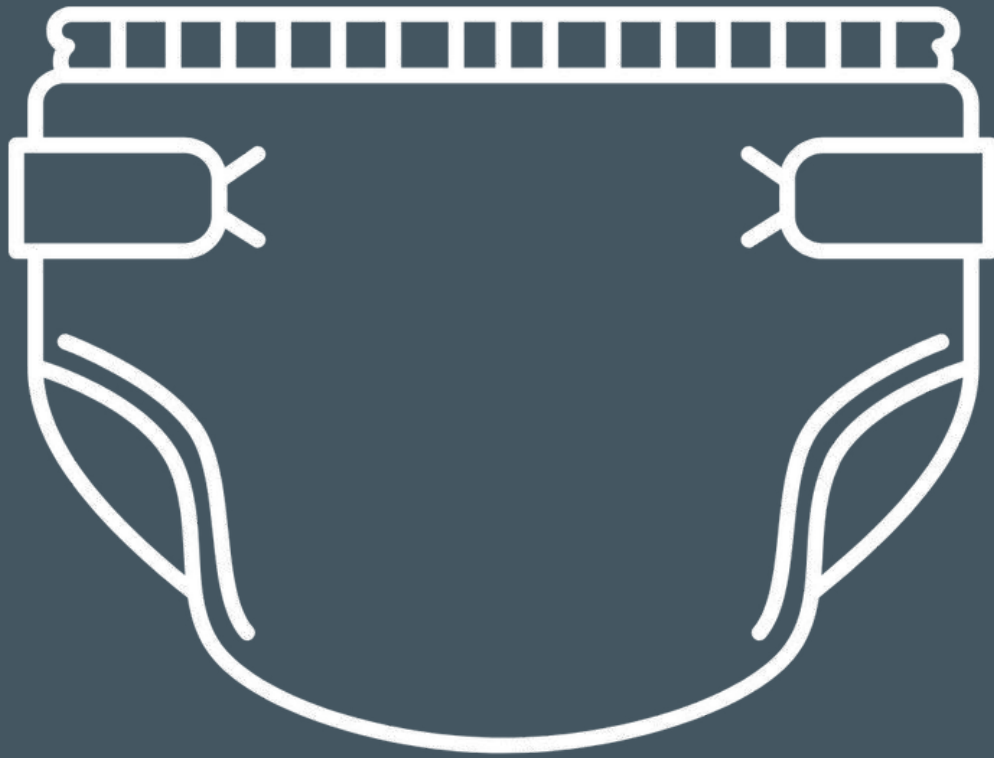
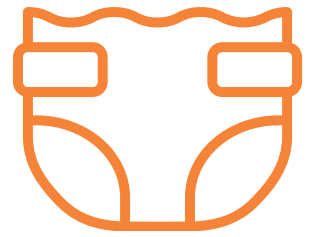

ABOUT Diaper Need



Diaper need is the lack of a sufficient number of diapers to keep a baby clean, dry, and healthy. Without consistent access to diapers, babies are more vulnerable to painful rashes or urinary tract infections, and have more trips to the doctor.

Today, nearly **1 in 2 U.S. families cannot afford enough diapers** to keep their infant or child clean, dry, and healthy. Of households experiencing diaper insecurity, **34% have reported skipping meals to afford diapers for their children.**

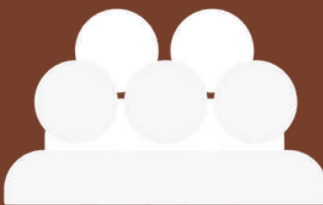
1 in 4 parents with diaper need miss work or school because they can't afford the diapers required to leave their baby in childcare.

Without clean diapers:

1. Babies are exposed to potential health risks and toxic stress.
2. Mothers are at risk for increased maternal depression.
3. Parents are unable to access childcare, which requires a daily supply of diapers.

WHAT CAN YOU DO?



1. RUN A DIAPER DRIVE
